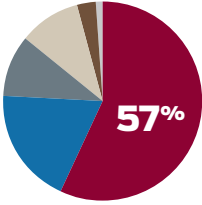

Employment Information for 2022 Graduates

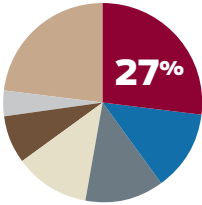
EMPLOYED BY JOB TYPE*
