



## The Loyola University Veterans Practicum

The Veterans Practicum is a cross-disciplinary effort in partnership with the School of Social Work designed to better address veterans' social and legal needs. Senior law students eligible for a 711 license will represent low-income veterans and their families in civil legal matters under the supervision of the Practicum's Director. This four-credit experiential learning course (LAW 586-001) requires students to attend a weekly class component on Wednesdays as well as weekly office hours. This is a first-come, first-served enrollment opportunity for eligible law students. Until further notice, this course will continue to be taught remotely with all court appearances and office hours occurring via Zoom.
