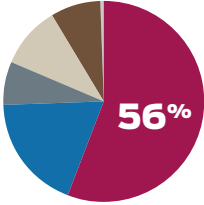

Employment Information for 2021 Graduates

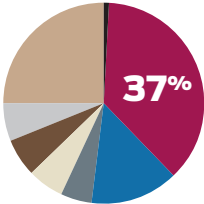
EMPLOYED BY JOB TYPE*
