# Graduation Rates: Fall Incoming First Years 2013-Fall 2017 PUBLIC VIEW

## HOW TO USE THIS DASHBOARD

This report looks at four and six year graduation rates for the Fall incoming first year cohorts for academic years 2013-2014 through 2017-2018. Students are assigned to school/department program based on their INITIAL enrollment, not their degree conferral school.

**Overview** shows the entering cohort of first year students and the calculated 4 and 6 year graduation rates.

### LIMITATIONS OF THE DATA.

Academic plan/subplan alignment to school given data architecture is ongoing - some programs may not be correctly assigned to schools and departments. Reporting of Race and Gender data may differ from other internal university data counts due to the way data must be reported to IPEDS.
