ORS ANNUAL REPORT FOR FY2016 (7/1/15 - 6/30/16)

A. INTRODUCTION AND HIGHLIGHTS OF PROPOSAL ACTIVITY FOR FY2016 BY UNIT

The Office of Research Services (ORS) staff continues to work diligently to provide a variety of services that support three functional goals: 1) to enhance research capacity, 2) to ensure research integrity and compliance, and 3) to maintain an infrastructure to support intellectual property management, technology transfer, and the commercialization of scientific activity. The following narrative summarizes activities in each of these areas.

1. Number of Proposals Submitted and Total Dollars Requested by Unit

- Grant-seeking by Loyola's Lakeside campus faculty remained robust for FY2016, with a record number of external funding proposals submitted
- Faculty submitted a total of 267 external grant proposals in FY2016 (see Section B below for detailed summaries and comparisons with prior years, and Appendix 2 for complete listing by Unit/Department), for a total of \$96,289,618 requested
- The five most active school/college center/units (in descending order) were: the College of Arts & Sciences (CAS), the School of Education (SOE), the School of Social Work (SSW), the Institute for Environmental Sustainability (IES) and the Center for Science and Math Education (CSME)

2. Number of Awards and Total Dollars Received by Unit

- 160 awards were received by Loyola's Lakeside faculty, a submission success rate of 60%
- Awards received totaled \$14,366,407 for an average award amount of \$89,790

3. Fulbright Scholar, NSF CAREER, and other Noteworthy Awards

- Dr. Maciek Nowak of the School of Business received a *Fulbright Scholar Award* to pursue a project entitled "Polish postal operations and the emerging supply chain" in Poland
- Dr. Timothy Hoellein of the Biology Department received an *NSF CAREER* award in the amount of \$699,749 for a research project entitled "Anthropogenic litter in freshwaters: An ecosystem approach"
- The federal Trio "Support for Success" award (total multi-year budget = \$1,181,010), the federal Trio "McNair Scholars" award (total multi-year budget = \$1,100,000), and the Howard Hughes Medical Institute "Innovate, Collaborate, Discover" grant (total multi-year budget = \$1,900,000) each received their respective renewals


- Loyola's Lakeside faculty received 160 grant awards in FY2016, a decline from last year, although the trend is for overall increase over 5-year period















E. STRATEGIES EMPLOYED BY ORS TO FACILITATE GRANT ACTIVITY

ORS has developed several initiatives to assist and encourage faculty in finding external support for their work and to enhance their ability to successfully secure external funding:

- 1. **Research Support Awards.** All tenure-track faculty may apply for Research Support Grants (RSGs) that provide up to \$5,000 in research support per academic year. This program is designed to promote high-quality research, scholarship, and creative activity by LUC faculty by:
 - Enabling faculty researchers to conduct smaller scale research to produce preliminary data for larger external grant proposals
 - Serving as "bridge" funding for active researchers typically supported by external funding but who are between awards
 - Enabling faculty to cover minor unanticipated expenses associated with externally-funded research in progress and thus promote successful and timely achievement of project goals
 - In FY2016, a total of \$64,731 was awarded to 13 faculty in eight departments
 - 11 of 13 awards (85%) resulted in submission of an external funding proposal
 - Awarded faculty have since submitted a total of \$2,037,890 in funding requests to external funding agencies (below), *an amount over 30 times that invested*

2. The ORS Faculty Research/Scholarly Interests Database

The Assistant Director for Research Development monitors and/or subscribes to more than 40 sources of funding opportunities that are screened weekly and either posted to the automated *Faculty Grants Notification System* (FGNS) or are sent directly to appropriate faculty, and also conducts custom searches for faculty and/or administration. The Faculty Grants Notification System (FGNS) serves to:

- Match faculty to potential funding opportunities based on their chosen research area keywords
- Automatically send faculty e-mail notifications about funding opportunities matching their keywords
- Feature profile pages with optional fields for research interest narratives, publication lists, CVs., and links to personal or lab web pages, in order to foster collaboration
- Facilitate the general increase in proposal submission over last 5 years since inception
- In FY2016, over 700 funding opportunities were posted in the FGNS
- In FY2016, approximately 120 funding opportunities were sent directly to faculty

3. Pivot Data Base

- Loyola subscribes to the Pivot database, the world's largest grants and funding database
- Pivot contains over \$44 billion in funding opportunities and more than 3 million scholar profiles
- Loyola faculty logged into Pivot 1405 times in FY2016

4. Faculty Outreach: Workshops and Webinars

ORS continues to expand our outreach education program, offering workshops and webinars that assist faculty in:

- > Orienting new faculty to working with ORS on submitting proposals
- Seeking funding opportunities and using funding databases
- Writing competitive grant proposals
- > Understanding new and modified federal regulations and compliance procedures
- Understanding Loyola's IRB and IACUC processes
- In FY2016, there were 20 ORS outreach events, 10 of which were unique (some events had more than one session), a 35% increase over FY2015:

2. Book Subvention Assistance Awards

- Aids faculty in publishing scholarly books accepted by university presses
- Covers production expenses required by the press up to \$2,000, including author's mandatory contribution

G. RESEARCH INTEGRITY AND COMPLIANCE

1. Record Systems

a. Integration of Compliance Approval Portal (CAP) and DocFinity Systems

- Back-up records of Internal Review Board (IRB) and Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) activities now managed by online CAP system
- New CAP module allows animal researchers to report census numbers via website
- Module electronically reminds P.I.s of reports due and provides enhanced tracking of animal census reports for IACUC members and ORS staff
- Currently beta-testing radiation safety module in CAP, to be launched December 2016

b. Transition to Paperless Records

- ORS worked with ITS to develop a record management/storage system using DocFinity
- New system allows old paper IRB records to be scanned, archived, and accessed digitally
- DocFinity system allows CAP system to send it documents for permanent archive

2. Assurances

- Renewal of four-year Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) assurance
- Annual Controlled Substances Audits/Inspections implemented and conducted (summer 2015)
- Annual Biosafety Audits/Inspections continue

3. IACUC and IRB Committees

• IRB leadership changes: Former IRB Vice-Chair stepped down; replaced with two new Vice-Chairs to share workload

4. Animal Care Facility (ACF) and Services

- Additional animal research sites added in IES (2 aquatic facilities) and additional environmental chambers for vertebrates on 5th floor Life Sciences Building (LSB)
- Animal Care/IACUC Oversight Change: Replacement of retiring attending veterinarian with two new veterinarians: One primary attending and one secondary attending

5. Compliance Training Programs

ORS provides compliance training in four areas: Responsible Conduct of Research and Scholarship (RCRS), Conflict of Interest (COI), use of human research subjects (IRB), and use of animal research subjects (IACUC). Training is provided by the Assistant Director for Research Compliance, expert faculty volunteers, and occasional outside professionals. In FY2016:

- Three RCRS two-day training programs were conducted: August 2015, February 2016, May 2016
- > Pilot program of RCRS training on 2 Saturdays in February; 30 attendees
- > COI, IRB, IACUC training conducted by on-line modules with mandatory competence exams
- On-line IACUC training with mandatory competence exams is specific for class of animals used (e.g. vertebrates)

6. Institutional Review Board (IRB) Review Activity

- IRB completed 1547 reviews using the online CAP system
- More reviews than applications reflects resubmittals (mean = 2.4 reviews per submission)
- Both IRB applications and thus reviews have declined over past 3 years
- Decline was due to fewer amendments needed and more research projects qualifying for exemptions, which does not require annual submission of continuing review




IRB Activity FY2013-2016*

7. Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC)


- IACUC completed reviewed 37 applications in FY2016 using the online CAP system
- More reviews than applications reflects resubmittals
- Applications have increased over the past 3 years due to hiring of several new animal researchers
