# INTRODUCTION

Loyola University Chicago, Office of Research Services (ORS) is dedicated to cultivating faculty research capacity, collaboration, creativity, and productivity. ORS staff works closely with university faculty and staff to provide administrative support in identifying research funding opportunities, assisting with budget preparation, as well as overall proposal preparation and submission, while adhering to sponsor and university policies. Additionally, ORS hosts multiple training sessions, provides regulatory support, and organizes compliance activities throughout the year.

An overview of ORS services provided are listed below:

## **GRANT SUBMISSIONS FOR FY2019**

Loyola's Lakeshore faculty successfully submitted 178 external grant proposals in FY19 to federal, state, industry, and independent organizations for a total of \$56,965,209 requested.

The five most active units for grant submissions were the College of Arts & Sciences (CAS), the Center for Science and Math Education (CSME), the School of Education (SOE), the School of Social Work (SSW), and the Institute of Environmental Sustainability (IES).



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





Throughout the year, ORS hosts a variety of outreach activities, offering workshops, webinars, trainings, and inspections to assist the research community in:


- Introducing ORS and the various services provided and how to access them.

#### INTERNAL AWARD FUNDING

### **ORS Advisory Board**

The Office of Research Services has established an advisory board comprised of both faculty and staff of the Loyola community. The advisory board is actively involved in the administration of sponsored research and meets quarterly to provide guidance on the operations of ORS. In addition, the faculty members of the ORS Advisory Board actively review applications for the internal Research Support Grants administered by ORS.



FY2019 Internal Awards

- 1. **Research Support Grants (RSGs).** All tenure-track faculty may apply for Research Support Grants (RSGs) that provide up to \$5,000 in research support. This program is designed to promote high-quality research, scholarship, and creative activity by:
  - Enabling faculty researchers to conduct smaller scale research to produce preliminary data for larger external grant proposals
  - Serving as "bridge" funding for active researchers typically supported by external funding but who are between awards
  - Enabling faculty to cover minor unanticipated expenses associated with externally-funded research in progress and thus promote successful and timely achievement of project goals

In FY2019, a total of \$82,445 in research support grants were awarded to seventeen (17) faculty members in eleven (11) departments. RSG awarded faculty submitted a total of \$2,308,008 in external sponsor funding requests.





- 4. Faculty Grant Notification System (FGNS). The Office of Research Services monitors and subscribes to a wide variety of resource sites and organizations that provide up-to-date funding opportunities. Funding announcements are disseminated multiple times weekly from ORS to the Lakeshore faculty. FGNS allows ORS to send out opportunities to specific faculty members based on the research interests they have provided. Additionally, faculty are able to add research key words, their curriculum vitae, publication lists, and their research narratives in the FNGS. In FY19, over 450 funding opportunity announcements were posted in FNGS and distributed among the Lakeshore Faculty.
- **5. Pivot Database.** ORS subscribes to Pivot, which is a database of grants, fellowships, and other funding opportunity announcements. One-hundred-sixty-four (164) Grants provided to the Lakeshore faculty are directly linked to Pivot searches as seen below.





**6. Faculty Outreach & Development.** Each year ORS hosts a variety of workshops, webinars, and other faculty development activities. In FY19, ORS in support of the University Mission continued to provide the Responsible Conduct of Research and Scholarship (RCRS) training. These sessions incorporate ethics education into the curriculum, which is a requirement for all students actively involved in research. The RCRS sessions are held throughout the year.

### **RESEARCH INTEGRITY AND COMPLIANCE FY2019**

#### Introduction

The Office of Research Services provides support services to both the committees charged with overseeing different types of activities as well as the research community. ORS assists faculty and staff to obtain the proper approval for their specific research, such as applying for and securing permits from governmental agencies (both federal and local) when required. Many research activities require compliance with federal, state, local, or granting agency requirements. In most cases, the research cannot begin without such compliance assurances. ORS offers up-to-date information and assistance pertaining to research compliance.

#### **Compliance Activities**

#### 1. Record Systems

- Updated IRB application and review guides in the online Compliance Application Portal (CAP) system to be final rule compliant.
- Developed Technology Tracking System (TTS), which will be tested and launched in FY 2020.

#### 2. Assurances

- Updated OHRP made to reflect current IRB Roster and Chairperson change.
- Facilitated on May 6, 2019, the IEMA Inspection on the Lake Shore Campus of registered equipment that produces radioactive energy-conducted.
- In June 2019, conducted the Annual Controlled Substances Audits/Inspections implemented and conducted.
- Conducted physical inspections of all laboratories that are using materials subject to Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC) oversight and reported findings to the IBC.
- Insured that mandated annual Biosafety Audits/Inspections were performed and reported to NIH by the IBC (IBC is registered with NIH).
- Received DEA and State of Illinois licensure to possess controlled substances (Schedule II-IV).

#### 3. IACUC and IRB Committees

- Revised IRB applications materials and procedures to be compliant with revised Common Rule.
- Made numerous presentations to inform researchers about the IRB and IACUC requirements as
  well as the applications procedures. This includes several presentations to various
  departments/schools, groups of faculty members, researcher's methodology classes, and student
  researchers (two programs are part of the Graduate School's ongoing researcher workshop
  series).

#### 4. Animal Care Facility (ACF) and Services

- Conducted monthly inspections of the ACF and provided recommendations to the Provost regarding resource needs. Initiated replacement of cage washer machine to be completed in FY 2020.
- Continued to provide oversight and consultation, via quarterly meetings to the Animal Care Facility Advisory Committee on management of the mammal research facility.
- Worked with the Committee to establish an ACF annual budget sufficient for purchase of supplies, replacement equipment, and veterinary care.

#### 5. Compliance Training Programs

ORS provides compliance training in four areas: Responsible Conduct of Research and Scholarship (RCRS), Conflict of Interest (COI), use of human research subjects (IRB), and use of animal research subjects (IACUC). The Associate Director of Research Compliance, expert faculty volunteers, and occasionally outside professionals provide compliance training.



## **IRB Activity Fiscal Years 2015-2019**







#### 7. Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC)

## **IACUC Activity Fiscal Years 2015-2019**







# 8. Research Safety: Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC), Radiation Safety Committee (RSC), Laboratory Safety Committee (LSC)
