

Loyola University Chicago will continue to offer summer U-Pass to undergraduates, The Quinlan School of Business Graduate Programs, and Arrupe College for the 2017 summer term.

Undergraduate Criteria:

Undergraduate students enrolled in 6 credit hours or more of in-person classes by the June 13, 2017 deadline will be eligible and assessed the **\$98.00 U-Pass fee**. This fee will be assessed through each students' LOCUS account. For qualified students, the pass will be active starting Monday, May 22, 2017 and will deactivate on Friday, August 11, 2017. Students will not have the option to opt out of the pass nor have the option to opt-in to the pass if they don't have the required 6 credit hours. **Students will qualify for the pass if they have a total of 6 credit hours in any of the following summer sessions at Loyola's Lakeside Campuses (LSC and WTC): 6 week 1, 6 week 2, 8 week 1 and 12 week 1. The early summer 4 week session is excluded from eligibility and the School of Continuing and Professional Studies sessions are also excluded. Classes must be in-person; online are excluded from qualifying for a U-Pass.**

Students that have not registered for at least 6 credit hours by the June 13, 2017 deadline will not be eligible for the summer U-Pass. As of June 13, 2017, all students that initially may have received the U-Pass benefit, but do not have at least 6 credit hours will have their passes deactivated and will not be charged the U-Pass fee. Students that fall below 6 credit hours AFTER June 13, 2017 will not have their passes deactivated and the charge will remain on their LOCUS account.

Distribution:

The U-Pass team will release information on a summer U-Pass distribution session once it is determined how many new students they will need to support for the summer program. If students have an existing Loyola University Chicago U-Pass, that pass will be turned on automatically at the start of the summer sessions (May 22, 2017). The only students that will need to pick up a U-Pass or have one created are first time students that have never received a Loyola University Chicago U-Pass. Students transferring from another Chicago area institution where they had a U-Pass will need to have a Loyola University Chicago U-Pass created.

Customer Service:

The U-Pass team will be offering the majority of its customer service through the Lake Shore Campus for the summer 2017. This includes replacement pass services, on-going distribution, and office hours. The U-Pass team, as always, will be available for customer service support via email at upass@luc.edu
