

SOCIAL STATISTICS COURSE: ONLINE COURSE

November 2008- January 2009

Students admitted into the Loyola MSW program are required to have successfully completed a statistics course with a grade of "C" or better, taken within the past 4 years. The transcripts sent for admission should reflect this requirement. If the statistics requirement has not been met, a non-credit class offered by the School of Social Work prior to the beginning of the semester in which you intend to enter will meet this requirement if a "P" is earned in the session for which the student is registered. Please note that non-credit courses do not appear on your transcript.

Once you have registered for the online class, your Loyola Computer ID will be provided to Information Technology to enroll you in the Online Social Statistics Course.

When enrollment is completed, the instructor will send you an email providing instructions on: 1) how to set up your computer for the online course; and 2) how to use Bb and the course content. Since you are registered through Loyola University Chicago, Bb uses your Loyola email address. If you are accustomed to using a different email address, you can have your Loyola email address forwarded by using PAM (Personal Account Manager). Instructions can be found on Loyola's home page.

If you have any problems with setting your computer up for the online course, you need to contact the IT technical staff at blackboard@luc.edu. If you have a question about Bb and the course content, you need to contact the instructor, Terri Kilbane, Ph.D., at tkilban@luc.edu.

The Online Social Statistics Course contains seven sessions. For each session there is: 1) an assigned reading from the text; 2) a PowerPoint presentation; 3) a taped lecture accompanying the PowerPoint presentation; and 4) an online quiz. Once you successfully pass the quiz (70% not including Bonus points), you proceed to the next session. Once you pass all seven quizzes, you need to contact Wendy Bednarz ***at least one week prior to the final*** at wbednarz@luc.edu to take the final in-person at the School of Social Work.
