PERU

The Peru summer program at the Universidad Antonio Ruiz de Montoya is a unique opportunity for students to experience a vibrant South American country. The program integrates experiential as well as academic learning to infuse students with a broad understanding of Peruvian social, economic, and political realities and to strengthen the student's Spanish language ability. As a part of their service-learning experience, students will work at and visit some of the more than 50 Jesuit projects in Peru. The group will be accompanied by bilingual staff from the Universidad Antonio Ruiz de Montoya, who have a broad experience in education based on the principles of the Jesuit world view.

COST:

6 semester hours tuition: \$3,480

Room, board, and in-country travel: \$2,085

COURSES:

Intensive Intermediate Spanish Language

Prerequisite: At least two semesters of college-level Spanish.
(3 semester hours credit)

Peruvian Social and Political Reality

This course will improve the student's understanding of Peruvian life and deepen their awareness of social justice issues in Peru.
(3 semester hours credit)

VIETNAM

The Vietnam summer program is an opportunity for students seeking an extraordinary experience in Vietnam. Students will increase their awareness and understanding of Vietnamese history, people, culture, and traditions by integrating coursework, service-learning, and cultural immersion. Students also will meet and work with local people as they gain insight into contemporary social, economic, religious, and political realities of living in Vietnam. The service-learning component of this program offers students a chance to promote justice while they work in either a rural orphanage or an urban volunteer site.

COST:

3 semester hours tuition: \$1,740

Room, board, and in-country travel: \$2,200

COURSE:

Society and State in Contemporary Vietnam

This course will widen and broaden the student's understanding of the Vietnamese people through an exploration of the cultural, social, political, economic, and religious aspects of their everyday life. (3 semester hours credit)
