## PROGRAM DOES NOT INCLUDE:

This three-and-a-half week summer program in Aix-en-Provence is an intensive immersion experience. Students are taught by resident French faculty at all levels, from elementary French to advanced courses in culture and civilization. Students receive six credit hours. They live in French university dorms, and mingle with a small cohort of students from around the world whose common interest is to advance their knowledge of the French language. A Loyola University Chicago faculty administrator is on hand at all times to accompany students on numerous excursions and cultural events, and to ensure the success of their experience in France.

This experience is ideal for students who wish to major or minor in French or to participate in a French language immersion experience.

## COURSE OFFERINGS

### *FREN 101/102: Introductory French*

Prerequisite: No previous knowledge of French. This course includes language instruction with developing proficiency in oral expression. (6 semester hours)

### *FREN 103/104: Intermediate French*

Prerequisite: One year of college French or the equivalent. This course includes an intensive review of the basic skills to develop audio-lingual facility in communication. This course is for students majoring or minoring in French. (6 semester hours)

### *FREN 250/251: Composition & Conversation*

Prerequisite: Two years of previous study at the college level. This course will help students develop greater fluency in speech and writing. (6 semester hours)

### *FREN 300: Tutorial for Credit*
