# 2009 Summer Study Abroad Program in Tunisia

Arab World, Islam, and U.S. Foreign Policy: Summer Study Course To Tunisia | May 31 - June 20

## FACULTY:

Professor Peter J. Schraeder, is a specialist in African politics (including North Africa) and U.S. foreign policy and is also fluent in English and French. This will be the fourth time Dr. Schraeder has lead this program in Tunisia. The trip will also include guest lectures from internationally acclaimed Tunisian scholars.

- 5/30** Depart U.S. for Tunisia
- 5/31** Arrive in Tunisia
- 6/20** Depart Tunisia for U.S.

## PROGRAM FEE OF \$2,130 INCLUDES:

- Shared occupancy in 4 – 5 star hotels
- 3 meals a day
- All in-country travel expenses (including travel by a new Mercedes bus and 4 x 4 Land Rovers)
- English-speaking Tunisian tour guide and local lecturers
- Entrance fees to all sites, such as Roman and Carthaginian ruins, religious sites (Islamic Mosques, Catholic Churches, and Jewish Temples), and museums
- Loyola Office for International Programs fee of \$100

## TUITION FEE OF \$1,740 INCLUDES:

- 3 credits Loyola summer school tuition

## PROGRAM FEE DOES NOT INCLUDE:

- Round-trip airfare (Chicago to Tunisia) approximately \$1,850
- Personal spending money
- Baggage insurance and excess baggage fees
- Medical/accident insurance
- Other incidental expenses
- Travel insurance
