Title:		Notifying Financial Clearance and Service Representatives that a service will be paid for by a research study				
Background:		The Financial Clearance Center (FCC) contacts a patient's insurance provider to confirm service or procedure will be covered by insurance when it is scheduled. Service Representatives (Front Desk staff) request and collect co-pays or pre-payments for a service or procedure when the patient presents to have the service performed. If a service or procedure is to be paid for by a research study, the patient's insurance should not be contacted and a co-payment or pre-payment should not be collected. This process details how the research team communicates that a service or procedure will be paid for by the research study so the FCC and Service Representatives can manage it appropriately.
