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Requirements

- Interest in working with elementary school children, in a Catholic School in the city of Chicago, and receiving a Professional Educator License (PEL) with an elementary endorsement (grades 1 -6) allowing you to teach self contained grades 1-6. LU CHOICE teachers can teach in grades 1-8. Those teaching 7th or 8th grade must also teach 6th grade in order to meet licensing requirements.
- 2) Willingness to participate in a spiritual formation program.
- 3) Commitment of 2 years
- 4) Admitance into the Graduate MED program at Loyola University Chicago.
- 5) The requirements listed below are to be met <u>after being admitted to the</u> <u>graduate program</u>. It is not necessary to complete these at the time of application.
 - ☆ Participants must meet the undergraduate requirements for Illinois state certification in elementary education. If a participant is lacking in an area, he/she will have to take (an) additional course(s) at the participant's expense. This is completed during the 2nd summer of the program. For a list of these requirements please see out <u>handbook</u> P. 6-7.

 \Rightarrow Participants <u>are not required</u> to take the GRE or Praxis exams.

Application Instructions

Step one: Complete the Graduate School Application

 Persons interested in being considered for the LU CHOICE program must complete the graduate school application for the <u>Elementary Education</u> <u>MED</u>. This is completed online and can be found at. <u>https://gpem.luc.edu/apply/</u>

Most of the information needed by LU CHOICE will be obtained from your Loyola University Chicago Graduate School application. Therefore, the LUC graduate application must be completed first, and <u>acceptance into the graduate</u> **program verified when applying to LU CHOICE.**

However, the LU CHOICE office needs one additional item. Email is the preferred method of submission. (see step 2 below).

<u>**In order to apply and be interviewed for the LU CHOICE progam you must</u> have been accepted into the graduate program.

Step Two: Essay to be submitted for the LU CHOICE Program.

Please write an essay of one to three pages.

Use the questions below to assist you in writing your LU CHOICE Essay.

Describe your motivations to be an elementary school teacher. Include the following in your answer:

- What experiences have you had with elementary-aged children?
- Have you participated in teaching related activities? (Coaching, mentoring, tutoring, teacher assistant, teaching)
- Describe experiences you may have had that have influenced you to pursue teaching in a Catholic school as part of the LU CHOICE program.
- Describe your life experiences which have influenced your view of social justice and why social justice is a vital aspect of preparing to teach in Catholic Schools.

Review the Loyola University Chicago and Greeley Center mission statements.
