# **Administrative History**

Celtic Women International (CWI) is a global non-profit whose mission is to honor, celebrate, and promote the cultural contributions of women in the Celtic diaspora. The first annual conference of CWI was hosted in Milwaukee in 1998.

The Chicago branch of Celtic Women International was formed in the spring of 2004 by CWI members Maureen Smith and Dana McDermott and is the oldest CWI regional branch. In the following years, the group established regular meetings featuring events like book clubs and Celtic culture presentations. CWI Chicago sponsors a collection of different annual events: a Brigid's Day/Imbolc Celebration, the Revolutionary Irish Women Series, and the CWI "Literary Salon" at the Irish Books, Arts, & Music Fest.

As of May 2024, Celtic Women International and the Chicago CWI Branch are active organizations.

#### **Scope and Content**

The Celtic Women International-Chicago records consist of 5 linear feet spanning the years 1998-2022. Materials include photographs, brochures, books, calendars, event programs, newsletters, photo boards, scrapbooks, and textile wall hangings.
