Administrative History

IMPACT Chicago teaches self-defense to women, girls, and people with disabilities, so they can prevent, minimize, and stop violence. IMPACT Chicago, founded in 1987, is a not-for-profit organization (403(b)), governed by a volunteer Board of Directors and an Administrative Team.

The mission of IMPACT Chicago is to end violence and build a non-violent world in which all people can live safely and with dignity. IMPACT strives to make its programming accessible to people of all economic, racial/ethnic, and social groups.

In 1986, Joe Connelly heard about the new self-defense training method of "Model Mugging." With Lonna Brooks as an instructor and Connie Conroy to coordinate outreach, Connelly founded the nonprofit Self-Empowerment Group of Chicago to teach these techniques. The first course was taught in August 1987 to 13 women.

Martha Thompson took her first Self-Empowerment Group class in 1988 and found that the program brought together many of her passions. She contributed to the growth of the organization for 32 years as a Director, Volunteer Coordinator, board member, and self-defense instructor.

In 1991, organizations in cities across the United States teaching self-defense influenced by the Model Mugging technique united to form Impact International, Inc. The affiliation is made up of independent chapters that provide empowerment focused self-defense training through teaching realistic scenarios, teaching verbal skills and the use of the voice, teaching full-force physical techniques, creating a supportive environment, and sensitivity to trauma.

Scope and Content

The IMPACT Chicago records consist of 3.5 linear feet of material and span the years 1988 to 2012. The collection has not been processed and is in the original order in which it was received from the donor. Materials include board meeting records, instructor information, newsletters, correspondence, reports, promotional flyers and postcards, evaluations, training packets, news clippings, grant applications and reports, and course handouts.
