## **Biographical/Administrative History**

Kathryn Lehar is an artist with a background in sculpture, photography, and ceramics. She was a member of Artemisia Gallery, a cooperative women's art gallery which promoted feminist ideas through topical exhibitions and educational events. Lehar has exhibited work in multiple venues throughout her career, including Artemisia Gallery, DePaul University, and the University of Illinois Chicago. Lehar received a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Sculpture from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago in 1967 and a Master of Fine Arts in Sculpture from the University of Illinois Chicago in 1978. She has received grants, awards, residencies, and prizes, such as a City of Chicago Cultural Grant in 1989 and a National Endowment for the Arts Grant for a sculpture in Washington D.C. in 1988. Her artwork has been published in various publications, including the *Chicago Tribune*, the *Chicago Sun-Times*, and the *New Art Examiner*.

Lehar is also a librarian and received a Master of Science in Library and Information Sciences at the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign in 1989. She has worked as a librarian at Northwestern University and with the Chicago Public Library.

### **Scope and Content**
