**Biographical History**

Nancy Plotkin (née Greenberg) graduated from the University of Illinois, Urbana with a degree in English Literature, and then proceeded to study sculpture and painting at The School of the Art Institute of Chicago. She holds both a Bachelor of Fine Arts and a master of Fine Arts from The School of the Art Institute. Plotkin has taught at the Museum of Contemporary Art in Chicago and Governor's State University. She was also a resident artist in Israel in the early 1990s.

Plotkin's exhibitions are numerous and include solo exhibitions at local venues in Chicago as well as exhibits in Jerusalem, Israel. In 1990, she received a Palmer Award from the Chicago Cultural Center.

Nancy Plotkin passed away at the age 81 in January of 2013.

**Scope and Content**

This collection spans the years 1984 to 2005 and is comprised of three sections: Biographical, Professional, and Audio/Visual. The collection contains mostly material from Plotkin's exhibitibts and other projects and also includes numerous reviews, and artist's statements. The A/V series includes slides from Plotkin's "Heads" exhibit.

**Series 1: Biographical / Professional, 1984-2005, n.d. Box 1**

Contains materials relating to Plotkin's personal life. Included are artist's statements, resumes, and biographies. The series also has materials related to Plotkin's career as an artist including cards, pamphlets, and booklets detailing her exhibits.
